A WILDLIFE carer needs more volunteer helpers.

Michele Phillips, who runs the Oakleigh South Wildlife Shelter, said registered carers were being inundated with injured and sick animals because of a lack of volunteers across the state.

In an effort to address the

shortfall, Ms Phillips is organising a training workshop for people interested in becoming full-time carers.

"They learn how to do rescues, how to look after the animals and then they can see whether they're interested in following through with it," Ms Phillips said.
